**ORDER**

**UPON HEARING** Counsel for the Applicants

**AND UPON READING** the affidavit of Don W Ebanks sworn herein

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:**



1. paragraph 7 of the Winding Up Order dated 30<sup>th</sup> July 2003 be varied by amending it to read as follows: "The Official Liquidators shall be entitled to receive remuneration for their services by reference to the time properly given by them and their staff in attending to matters arising in the winding-up and the hourly rates and the amount of remuneration shall be determined in accordance with Rules 4.127 – 131", with paragraphs 7 (i) to (iii) remaining unchanged;
2. this Order shall not prevent a Liquidation Committee or the creditors from agreeing that the official liquidators' remuneration be fixed as a percentage of the value of the assets which are realised or distributed";
3. a formal committee of creditors be formed within 50 days;
4. a copy of Grand Court Practice Direction No. 2/2003 and a copy of the documents entitled "A Creditors' Guide to Liquidators' Fees Cayman Islands" dated 30<sup>th</sup> June 2003 be delivered to all creditors;

5. Don W Ebanks of Ernst & Young Ltd., of 4<sup>th</sup> Floor, Bermuda House, British American Centre, Dr Roy's Drive, George Town, Grand Cayman be discharged as one of the Joint Official Liquidators of the Company;
6. Richard Fogerty of Ernst & Young Ltd. of 4<sup>th</sup> Floor, Bermuda House, British American Centre, Dr Roy's Drive, George Town, Grand Cayman be appointed a Joint Official Liquidator of the Company; and,
5. that the costs of this application be paid from the assets of the Group Companies as defined in the Pooling Order dated 24<sup>th</sup> July 2003.
